REPORT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ON THE ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE BAHAMAS FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

- 1. At the 1731st meeting, held on 17 July 1973, the Security Council had before it the application of the Commonwealth of the Bahamas for admission to membership in the United Nations (S/10966). In accordance with rule 59 of the provisional rules of procedure, the President of the Security Council referred the application to the Committee on the Admission of New Members, requesting it to examine the application and report its conclusions.
- 2. At its 43rd meeting, held on 17 July, the Committee considered the application of the Commonwealth of the Bahamas and unanimously decided to recommend to the Security Council that the Commonwealth of the Bahamas be admitted to membership in the United Nations.
- 3. Accordingly, the Committee decided to recommend that the Security Council adopt the following draft resolution:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of the Commonwealth of the Bahamas for admission to membership in the United Nations (S/10966),

Recommends to the General Assembly that the Commonwealth of the Bahamas be admitted to membership in the United Nations."
