Letter dated 20 December 1973 from the permanent representative
of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to the United Nations
addressed to the Secretary-General

In connexion with the letter dated 7 December 1973 from the permanent representatives of the United States, the United Kingdom and France to the United Nations (A/9431-S/11150) the Soviet side deems it necessary to reaffirm its position on the question of the representation of the interests of West Berlin in the United Nations and its organs in accordance with the Quadripartite Agreement of 3 September 1971, as stated in the letter dated 26 June 1973 from the Soviet representative addressed to the Secretary-General of the United Nations (A/9082-S/10958). That position remains unchanged.

I request you, Sir, to circulate this letter as an official document of the Security Council and the General Assembly.
