REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS
OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN
AND NORTHERN IRELAND ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a telegram dated 13 August 1973 from the Secretary of State for Foreign and Commonwealth Affairs of the United Kingdom, stating that Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland has appointed Sir Donald Maitland, K.C.M.G., O.B.E., as Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom to the United Nations and instructed him to represent Her Majesty's Government in all organs of the United Nations.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this telegram constitutes adequate provisional credentials for Sir Donald Maitland to represent the United Kingdom on the Security Council.
