D. Agenda and organization of work

 - (d) Statistics of services (programme review);
 - (e) International Comparison Programme;
 - (f) International merchandise trade statistics;
 - (g) Statistics of international trade in services;
 - (h) Finance statistics;
 - (i) Ottawa Group on Price Indexes;
 - (j) Intersecretariat Working Group on Price Statistics.
5. Natural resources and environment statistics.
6. Activities not classified by field:
 - (a) International economic and social classifications;
 - (b) Harmonization of indicators and reporting on progress towards the millennium development goals;
 - (c) Statistical capacity-building;
 - (d) Follow-up to Economic and Social Council policy decisions;

- (e) Coordination and integration of statistical programmes;
 - (f) Programme questions (United Nations Statistics Division).
