Further progress report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Emergency Force

As indicated in my letter of 18 January 1974 to the President of the Security Council (S/11198 and Add.1), an Agreement on the disengagement of forces in pursuance of the Geneva Peace Conference was signed by the Chief of Staff of the Egyptian Armed Forces and the Chief of Staff of the Israel Defence Force, and by the Commander of UNEF as witness, at a meeting held at Kilometre 101 on the Cairo-Suez Road at 1025 hours GMT on the same day.

Since that time, five further meetings have been held at Kilometre 101, under the chairmanship of the Force Commander, in order to work out procedures for the implementation of the Agreement of 18 January. At the final meeting held on 24 January, the parties signed maps on which different phases of disengagement were represented and a time-table giving the details of the actions to be undertaken by the parties and UNEF in each phase. In accordance with the Agreement on disengagement, its implementation will be concluded on 5 March 1974, and UNEF will then have to conduct a final inspection to verify the complete implementation of the disengagement plan. The findings of UNEF will be submitted to the parties in a report on 9 March.
