Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and United States of America: revised draft resolution

The Security Council,

Having considered the reports of the Secretary-General contained in S/11302 and Add.1, and having heard his statement made at the 1773rd meeting of the Security Council,

- 1. <u>Welcomes</u> the Agreement on Disengagement between Israeli and Syrian Forces, negotiated in implementation of United Nations Security Council resolution 338 dated 22 October 1973;
- 2. Takes note of the Secretary-General's report, its annexes and his statement,
- 3. Decides to set up immediately under its authority a United Nations Disengagement Observer Force, and requests the Secretary-General to take the necessary steps to this effect in accordance with his above-mentioned report and the annexes thereto. The Force shall be established for an initial period of six months, subject to renewal by further resolution of the Security Council;
- 4. Requests the Secretary-General to keep the Security Council fully informed of further developments.
