LETTER DATED 14 JANUARY 2003 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS TO THE CONFERENCE ON DISARMAMENT ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE CONFERENCE ON DISARMAMENT CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE OF A DECREE ON PROLONGATION OF THE MORATORIUM ON EXPORTS OF ANTI-PERSONNEL LAND MINES

Excellency,

I have the honour to inform you that, on 13 January 2003, the President of the Republic of Belarus has issued a decree about prolongation of the moratorium to export of anti-personnel land mines.

The document renews to the end of 2007 the moratorium on export of all types of anti-personnel landmines pronounced by our country from August 22, 1995.

This step is directed for furthering the international efforts on non-proliferation and elimination of anti-personnel mines, covered by the Convention on the Prohibition of the Use, Stockpiling, Production and Transfer of Anti-Personnel Mines and on Their Destruction.

I would be very grateful if you could have the present communication published as an official document of the Conference on Disarmament.
