REPORT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ON THE ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF QATAR FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

- 1. At the 1577th meeting on 14 September 1971, the Security Council had before it the application of Qatar (S/10306) for admission to membership in the United Nations. The President of the Security Council referred the application to the Committee for examination and report in accordance with rule 59 of the provisional rules of procedure.
- 2. At its 37th meeting, held on 14 September 1971, the Committee considered the application of Qatar and unanimously decided to recommend to the Security Council that Qatar be admitted to membership in the United Nations.
- 3. The Committee, recalling its recommendation, in its report of 16 August 1971 (S/10294), as regards the application of Oman, further decided to recommend to the Security Council to have recourse to the last paragraph of rule 60 of the provisional rules of procedure.
- 4. Accordingly, the Committee decided to recommend to the Security Council the adoption of the following draft resolution:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of Qatar for admission to the United Nations (S/10306),

"Recommends to the General Assembly that Qatar be admitted to membership in the United Nations."
