LETTER DATED 1 AUGUST 1972 FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE
ON THE SITUATION WITH REGARD TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DECLARATION
ON THE GRANTING OF INDEPENDENCE TO COLONIAL COUNTRIES AND PEOPLES
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to my letter dated 16 April 1972 (S/10624) and in accordance with a decision taken by the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples at its 876th meeting, on 1 August 1972, I have the honour to transmit herewith for the attention of the Security Council the report of the Special Mission established by the Special Committee at its 840th meeting on 14 March 1972 to visit the liberated areas of Guinea (Bissau) (A/AC.109/L.804). 1/ In transmitting the report, I wish to draw particular attention to the conclusions and recommendations contained in paragraphs 71 to 82 of the report, which the Special Committee endorsed at the same meeting.

In accordance with the same decision, I wish also to transmit to you, for the attention of the Security Council, copies of the verbatim records of the relevant meetings of the Special Committee (A/AC.109/PV.875 and 876). 2/
