Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 751 (1992) concerning Somalia

Note verbale dated 10 March 2003 from the Permanent Mission of Ukraine to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Ukraine presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 751 (1992) concerning Somalia and, with reference to Security Council resolution 1407 (2002) of 3 May 2002, and in addition to the earlier notification provided by Ukraine (S/AC.29/2002/36), has the honour to further inform the Committee of the additional measures taken by the Government of Ukraine to ensure the full and effective implementation of the arms embargo against Somalia.

On 25 December 2002 the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine adopted Decree No. 1955, which instructs the relevant authorities in Ukraine to ensure the implementation of Security Council resolutions 733 (1992) and 1425 (2002), concerning a general and complete embargo on all deliveries of weapons and military equipment to Somalia, including the prohibition of the financing of all acquisitions and deliveries of weapons and military equipment and the prohibition of the direct or indirect supply to Somalia of technical advice, financial and other assistance, and training related to military activities.

The above-mentioned decree replaced the earlier Decree No. 66 of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine, of 10 February 1992, concerning the implementation of Security Council resolution 733 (1992).
