LETTER DATED 18 JANUARY 1972 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED
TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

..... I have the honour to transmit herewith the text of resolution 2795 (XXVI) concerning the question of Territories under Portuguese administration,* which was adopted by the General Assembly at its 2012th plenary meeting, on 10 December 1971.

By operative paragraph 14 of this resolution, the General Assembly

"14. Draws the attention of the Security Council, in view of the further deterioration of the situation in the Territories of Angola, Mozambique and Guinea (Bissau) which seriously disturbs international peace and security, to the urgent necessity to consider taking all effective steps, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter of the United Nations, to secure the full and speedy implementation by Portugal of resolution 1514 (XV) and of the decisions of the Security Council concerning the Territories under Portuguese domination."
