# **Election of 13 members of the Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting**

## Note by the Secretary-General

1. Pursuant to Economic and Social Council resolutions 1982/67 and 1985/71, the Council is to elect, at its resumed organizational session for 2003, 11 members of the Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2004 to fill the vacancies that will occur on 31 December 2003 upon the expiration of the terms of the following members: Algeria, Benin, Brazil, Cameroon, Costa Rica, Cyprus, Hungary, Jordan, Malaysia, Pakistan and Sierra Leone. There are two vacancies in the Working Group that were not filled for members whose terms expire on 31 December 2003.

2. The members are to be elected according to the following pattern:

Four members from African States;

Four members from Asian States;

Two members from Eastern European States;

Three members from Latin American and Caribbean States.
