LETTER DATED 13 MARCH 1972 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF PAKISTAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to enclose, under instructions of my Government, particulars of further violations of the cease-fire by the Indian armed forces during the period from 9 February to 14 February 1972. These violations are listed in the annex to this letter.

# Annex

### CEASE-FIRE VIOLATIONS BY INDIAN ARMED FORCES

## Azad Kashmir

- (1) On 9 February 1972, Indian troops were observed constructing new bunkers in area grid references 127777 and 128776 in Hajira sector.
- (2) On 9 February 1972, Indian troops fired three mortar bombs from area grid reference 180498 towards 168485 in Kotli sector.
- (3) On 9 February 1972, Indian troops were observed constructing new bunkers in area grid reference 126095 in Kotli sector.
- (4) On 9 February 1972, Indian troops were seen strengthening defences in area grid references 128094, 310884 and 320932.
- (5) On 9 February 1972, about 14 Indian soldiers were seen constructing new bunkers in area grid reference 258974 in Mirpur sector.
- (6) On 9 February 1972, Indian troops were seen constructing new bunkers in area grid references 451718, 562685, 559655, 563654 and 585648 in Chhamb sector.
- (7) On 10 February 1972, Indian troops were seen constructing new bunkers in area KERI grid reference 127074 in Kotli sector.
- (8) On 11 February 1972, Indian troops were seen constructing bunkers in area grid references 128097, 118078, 258974 and 322903 in Mirpur sector.
- (9) On 11 February 1972, Indian troops were observed strengthening their position by digging new trenches in area grid references 521696, 563634, 585650, 606554, 644535, 559654 and 562653 in Chhamb sector.
- (10) On 14 February 1972, about 15 Indian soldiers crossed the temporary cease-fire line and came approximately 200 yards inside the territory under Pakistan control in area grid reference 968688 in Tithwal sector. They fired 300 rounds of machine-gun and 50 bombs of 4.2-inch mortar from areas Datgali 9871 and Chunkan Baihk 0070. They were challenged by Pakistan troops.
- (11) On 14 February 1972, Indian troops were observed constructing new bunkers in area grid reference 155097 in Kotli sector.
- (12) On 14 February 1972, Indian troops were observed digging new trenches in area grid references 063588, 068588, 071583, 072595 and 0722572 in Hajira sector.

- (13) On 14 February 1972, Indian troops were seen constructing bunkers in grid references 116066 and 258974 in Mirpur sector.
- (14) On 14 February 1972, Indian troops were seen constructing new bunkers in area grid references 411731, 595584 and 605554 in Chhamb sector.

# Sialkot sector:

On 11 February 1972, Indian troops set some houses on fire in village Tarapur grid reference 2017.
