**PROPOSED PROGRAMME CHANGES FOR 2003**

**SUMMARY**

The present document contains proposed changes to the programme of work, 2002-2003. The programme changes are necessitated by the directive of the Commission, at its fifty-eighth session, that the secretariat realign the programme of work, 2002-2003, with the new programme structure, as set out in the revisions to the medium-term plan for 2002-2005.

The proposed changes have no additional programme budget implications.

The Commission is invited to review this document with a view to endorsing it.

### **Introduction**

1. The Commission, at its fifty-eighth session, requested the secretariat to realign the programme of work for the biennium 2002-2003, without further delay, in order to bring into effect the new programme structure set out in the revisions to the medium-term plan for 2002-2005.
2. In accordance with the above directive, the secretariat has reconfigured and realigned the programme of work for 2002-2003 with the objectives and expected accomplishments of the revised medium-term plan for 2002-2005, as contained in E/ESCAP/1285/Add.1.
3. Under the new structure, certain outputs as originally formulated in the programme of work for 2002-2003 require modification to fit into the logical framework of the seven subprogrammes under the ESCAP programme of work. In other cases, outputs need to be deleted, as they are not in line with the new programme direction.
4. The present document contains proposed programme changes for 2003 designed to ensure full realignment of the programme of work with the revised medium-term plan for 2002-2005.
5. The main features of the proposed programme changes for 2003 are:
  - Deletion of the Sixth Asian and Pacific Ministerial Conference on Social Development, scheduled for 2003, which was intended as a follow-up to the World Summit for Social Development, in view of the shift in priority to follow-up on the outcomes of the Millennium Summit, the International Conference on Financing for Development and the World Summit on Sustainable Development.
  - Changes to parliamentary documentation for the Commission, thematic committees and subcommittees to meet the requirements of the new conference structure, as adopted in resolution 58/1. Some reports, which were originally intended for the Commission, should now be submitted to the relevant thematic committees instead. Similarly, the content of some reports, which were originally intended for the committees under the former conference structure, needs to be revised to focus on new priority areas and channelled to the relevant subcommittees.
  - Deletion of certain outputs, including seven publications, which have weak linkages with the new priority areas and the modified expected accomplishments under the respective subprogrammes.
  - Modification of outputs to strengthen their linkages to the new priority areas and the modified expected accomplishments under the respective subprogrammes.
  - Addition of outputs to facilitate the achievement of the modified expected accomplishments under the respective subprogrammes.
6. The programme changes being proposed have no additional financial implications, as available resources will be shifted internally to enable the secretariat to deliver the outputs and services.
7. The Commission is invited to review the proposals with a view to endorsing them.
