SPECIAL REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON
RECENT DEVELOPMENTS IN CYPRUS

Addendum

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General, Mr. B. F. Osorio-Tafall, and the Force Commander, Major-General D. Prem Chand, have informed the Secretary-General that the improved arrangement for the safe storage and supervision of the arms and ammunition imported by the Government of Cyprus in January 1972 and described in the previous special report to the Security Council (S/10564/Add.1) has been put into effect. Owing to technical difficulties relating to safety, it has not yet been possible to remove the fuses from some of the high explosive munitions. For the time being, therefore, these remain fused and stored under double lock and key at the Cyprus Government Police Headquarters in Athalassa. A solution which will meet the requirements of safety is being explored at the technical level.
