Corrigendum

1. Paragraph 123, last sentence

The last part of the sentence should read as follows:

"they create a climate of insecurity and instability and are fraught with a threat to peace and security in the region."

2. Paragraph 127, last sentence

The last sentence should begin as follows:

"Furthermore, it reaches the conclusion..."

3. Paragraph 128

Under the heading "B - Guinea (Bissau)", sub-paragraph (b) should be amended to read:

"(b) that it should be possible for the inalienable right deriving from this principle to be exercised without further delay."

Under the heading "C - Portugal", the first paragraph should be amended to read:

"The Special Mission accordingly recommends to the Security Council that it should take all appropriate steps and initiatives in order to induce Portugal to respect and fully implement the recommendations set forth above."
