Letter dated 19 March 2003 from the Permanent Representative of Italy to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism

I have the honour to inform you that on 14 February 2003 the Italian Parliament passed a law on the ratification and execution of the International Convention for the Suppression of Terrorist Bombings, adopted in New York by the General Assembly on 15 December 1997, and on the consequent adjustment of internal legislation.

In that regard, we would like to underline that Italy has now ratified all the 12 United Nations conventions aimed at fighting against terrorism. We would be grateful to the Counter-Terrorism Committee (CTC) for updating accordingly the supplementary report of Italy on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1373 (2001) (see S/2002/1390), as well as the relevant section of the CTC web site.
