REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY
COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE
UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND ON THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 5 August 1970 from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs of the United Kingdom, stating that Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland have appointed Sir Colin Crowe, K.C.M.G., as Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom to the United Nations and instructed him to represent Her Majesty's Government in all organs of the United Nations.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this letter constitutes adequate credentials.
