REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL
CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE DEPUTY REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED
STATES OF AMERICA ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL
