LETTER DATED 6 NOVEMBER 1970 ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF BURUNDI, NEPAL, SIERRA LEONE, SYRIA AND ZAMRIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS

We have the honour to request an early meeting of the Security Council to discuss the question of Southern Rhodesia. As you will recall, the Council last discussed this all important question in March 1970 and since the adoption of resolution 277 (1970), a number of disturbing political and economic developments have taken place in that rebel territory which require the close examination and attention of the Security Council.
