LETTER DATED 14 DECEMBER 1970 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
SINGAPORE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to enclose herewith the text of a message which my Foreign Minister conveyed to the Foreign Minister of the Republic of Guinea. The message refers to the question which was considered by the Security Council at its meetings held on 22 November, and 4, 5, 7 and 8 December. I have been requested by my Government to request you to circulate the text of the message as an official document of the United Nations Security Council.
