LETTER DATED 21 DECEMBER 1970 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to transmit herewith the text of resolution 2671 F (XXV) adopted by the General Assembly on 8 December 1970 on "the pelicies of apartheid of the Government of the Republic of South Africa".

In adopting this resolution, the General Assembly, in paragraph 6, "again draws the attention of the Security Council to the grave situation in South Africa, and in southern Africa as a whole, and recommends that the Council resume urgently the consideration of effective measures, in the light of relevant General Assembly resolutions, including those under Chapter VII of the Charter".
