REPORT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ON THE ADMISSION OF
NEW MEMBERS CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC
REPUBLIC AND THE APPLICATION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY
FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

1. At its 1729th meeting, held on 21 June 1973, the Security Council considered the application of the German Democratic Republic and the application of the Federal Republic of Germany for the admission of each to membership in the United Nations (S/10945 and S/10949). In accordance with rule 59 of the provisional rules of procedure and with the decision taken by the Council at its 1729th meeting, the President of the Security Council referred the two applications to the Committee on the Admission of New Members, requesting it to examine the applications and report its conclusions.

2. At its 42nd meeting, held on 21 June 1973, the Committee considered the application of the German Democratic Republic and the application of the Federal Republic of Germany and unanimously decided to recommend to the Security Council the admission of the German Democratic Republic and of the Federal Republic of Germany to membership in the United Nations.

3. Accordingly, the Committee decided to recommend that the Security Council adopt the following draft resolution:

"The Security Council,

"Having considered separately the application of the German Democratic Republic (S/10945) and the application of the Federal Republic of Germany (S/10949) for admission to membership in the United Nations,

"1. Recommends to the General Assembly that the German Democratic Republic be admitted to membership in the United Nations;

"2 Recommends to the General Assembly that the Federal Republic of Germany be admitted to membership in the United Nations."
