GENERAL AND COMPLETE DISARMAMENT: PROH. SITION OF THE DEVELOPMENT, PRODUCTION, STOCKPILING AND USE OF RADIOLOGICAL WEAPONS

Hungary, andonesia, Sweden and United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Treland: draft resolution

Prohibition of the development, production, stockpiling and use of radiological weapons

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 42/38 B of 30 November 1987,

- 1. Takes note of the part of the report of the Conference on Disarmament on its 1986 session as well as that of the special report of the Conference on Disarmament, that deal with the question of radiological weapons, in particular the reports of the Ad Hoc Committee on Radiological Weapons; 1/
- 2. Recognizes that the Ad Hoc Committee in 1988 made a further contribution to the clarification and better understanding of different approaches which continue to exist with regard to both of the important subjects under consideration;
- 3. Takes note of the recommendation of the Conference on Disarmament that the Ad Hoc Committee on Radiological Weapons should be re-established at the beginning of its 1989 session;

- 4. Requests the Conference on Disarmament to continue its negotiations on the subject with a view to a prompt conclusion of its work, taking into account all proposals presented to the Conference to this end and drawing upon the annexes to its report as a basis of its future work, the result of which should be submitted to the General Assembly at its forty-fourth session;
- 5. Also requests that the Secretary-General transmit to the Conference on Disarmament all relevant documents relating to the discussion of all aspects of the issue by the General Assembly at its forty-third session;
- 6. <u>Decides</u> to include in the provisional agenda of its forty-fourth session the item entitled "Prohibition of the development, production, stockpiling and \se of radiological weapons".
