NOTE BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

By its resolution 283 (1970), the Security Council decided to re-establish, in accordance with rule 28 of the provisional rules of procedure, the Ad Hoc Sub-Committee on Namibia. The terms of reference of this Ad Hoc Sub-Committee are contained in operative paragraphs 14 and 15 of that resolution.

After consultations among the members of the Security Council agreement has been reached on the following:

1. The Ad Hoc Sub-Committee on Namibia shall be composed of all members of the Security Council;
2. The Ad Hoc Sub-Committee on Namibia should work under the same procedures as those followed by the Ad Hoc Sub-Committee established in pursuance of Security Council resolution 276 (1970);
3. With regard to the bureau of the Ad Hoc Sub-Committee on Namibia which will have to be elected, it is the general feeling among the members of the Security Council that the composition of the bureau might be the same as that of the Ad Hoc Sub-Committee established in pursuance of Security Council resolution 276 (1970).
