LETTER DATED 12 AUGUST 1970 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF JORDAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY GENERAL

Further to my letters of 16 July (A/7988, S/9868) and 23 July (A/7997, S/9885) concerning Israel's continued and forcible expulsion of Arab inhabitants from occupied territories, I regret to bring to Your Excellency's attention that Israel continues to follow such policies.

During the last three weeks, Israeli occupying forces expelled thirty Jordanian citizens from different towns and villages of the West Bank of Jordan.

This and other Israeli measures and policies are not only in direct violation of relevant United Nations resolutions and the Charter, but also undermine present efforts for a just and political solution.

I would appreciate it if this letter be circulated as an official document of the General Assembly and the Security Council.
