Confirmation of the appointment of three members of the Investments Committee

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 11th meeting, on 14 October 1983, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/38/104) concerning the vacancies arising in the Investments Committee as a result of the expiration of the terms of office of three of its members on 31 December 1983.
- 2. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/38/24) in which, in accordance with the provisions of article 20 of the regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, the Secretary-General submitted for confirmation by the General Assembly the reappointment as members of the Investments Committee of Mr. David Montagu (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Norther Ireland), Mr. Yves Oltramare (Switzerland) and Mr. Emmanuel Noi Omaboe (Ghana) for three-year terms beginning on 1 January 1984.
- 3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it should confirm the reappointment as members of the Investments Committee of Mr. David Montagu, Mr. Yves Oltramare and Mr. Emmanuel Noi Omaboe for three year terms beginning on 1 January 1984.
