Appointment of two members of the United Nations  
Administrative Tribunal

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Even FONTAINE ORTIZ (Cuba)

1. At its 11th meeting, on 14 October 1983, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/38/105 and Corr.1) concerning the vacancies in the membership of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal which will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of two of its members on 31 December 1983.
2. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/38/21) containing the names of two persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment to the United Nations Administrative Tribunal.
3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend Mr. Arnold Wilfred Geoffrey Kean (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) and Mr. Herbert Reis (United States of America) for reappointment as members of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 1984.
