QUESTION OF NAMIBIA

Report of the Fourth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Emmanuel DOUMA (Congo)

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 23 September 1988, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its forty-third session the item entitled "Question of Namibia". At the same meeting, the Assembly decided that the item would be considered directly in plenary meeting, on the understanding that hearings of the organizations concerned would be held in the Fourth Committee.
