Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

During the week ending 5 July 2003, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4781st (private) meeting, held on 1 July 2003 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

At the close of the meeting, in accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

"On 1 July 2003, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B, of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 4781st meeting in private with the

troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Iraq-Kuwait Observation Mission (UNIKOM).

"The Security Council and the troop-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Julian Harston, Acting Director of the Asia and Middle East Division of the Department of Peacekeeping Operations.

"The members of the Council had a constructive exchange of views with representatives of participating troop-contributing countries."

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4782nd meeting, held on 3 July 2003 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (S/2003/675).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Albania, Italy, Japan and Serbia and Montenegro, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Michael Steiner, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4783rd meeting, held on 3 July 2003 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the activities of the United Nations Iraq-Kuwait Observation Mission (S/2003/656).

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2003/684) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2003/684, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1490 (2003) (for the text, see S/RES/1490 (2003); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2002-31 July 2003*).
