USSR: draft resolution

The Security Council,

Gravely concerned by the conflict in the Indo-Palistan subcontinent, which constitutes an immediate threat to international peace and security,

- 1. <u>Calls upon</u> all the parties concerned to take steps for bringing about immediate ceasefire and cessation of all hostilities on the eastern and western fronts;
- 2. <u>Calls for</u> the simultaneous conclusion of a political settlement in accordance with the wishes of the people of East Pakistan as declared through their already elected representatives;
- 3. Calls upon all those concerned to take all measures necessary to preserve human life and to observe the Geneva Conventions of 1949;
- 4. Requests the Secretary-General to keep the Council promptly and currently informed of the implementation of this resolution;
- 5. <u>Decides</u> to continue to discuss the further measures to be taken in order to restore peace in the whole area.
