NOTE BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

The President of the Security Council wishes to bring the following information to the attention of members of the Council:

On 23 March 1970, at its twenty-sixth session, the Commission on Human Rights adopted resolution 10 (XXVI) entitled "Question of human rights in the territories occupied as a result of hostilities in the Middle East, including the report of the Special Working Group of Experts". In operative paragraph 13 of resolution 10 (XXVI), the Commission requested the Secretary-General to "bring to the attention of the General Assembly, the Security Council and the Economic and Social Council" the text of that resolution and the report of the Special Working Group of Experts established under resolution 6 (XXV) of the Commission to investigate allegations concerning Israel's violation of the Geneva Convention of 12 August 1949 relative to the Protection of Civilian Persons in Time of War in the territories occupied by Israel as a result of hostilities in the Middle East. In its resolution 1504 (XLVIII) of 27 May 1970, the Economic and Social Council took note of the report of the Commission on Human Rights containing resolution 10 (XXVI). The Secretary-General has accordingly requested the President of the Security Council to bring to the attention of the members of the Council the text of that resolution^{1/} as well as the report of the Special Working Group of Experts established by resolution 6 (XXV) of the Commission.^{2/}
