

Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/2003/40 of 14 February 2003, S/2003/40/Add.3 of 21 February 2003, S/2003/40/Add.14 of 24 February 2003, S/2003/40/Add.11 of 28 March 2003, S/2003/40/Add.14 of 17 April 2003, S/2003/40/Add.19 of 23 May 2003, S/2003/40/Add.20 of 30 May 2003 and S/2003/40/Add.24 of 27 June 2003.

During the week ending 16 August 2003, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The situation concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo (see

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4807th meeting, held on 13 August 2003 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it a letter dated 15 October 2002 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2002/1146 and Add.1).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2003/803) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2003/803, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1499 (2003) (for the text, see S/RES/1499

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4808th meeting, held on 14 August 2003 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General pursuant to paragraph 24 of Security Council resolution 1483 (2003) (S/2003/715).

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2003/812) submitted by Angola, Bulgaria, Cameroon, Chile, Guinea, Spain, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2003/812, which received 14 votes in favour to none against, with one abstention (Syrian Arab Republic) and was adopted as resolution 1500 (2003) (for the text, see S/RES/1500 (2003); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2003-31 July 2004*).
