REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE DEPUTY AND ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 12 September 1979 from the Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the United Nations stating that Mr. W. E. Hamilton Whyte has been appointed deputy representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland on the Security Council and Mr. Marrack I. Goulding and Miss Sheila E. Harden, O.B.E., alternate representatives.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this letter constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
