LETTER DATED 29 JULY 1970 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF JORDAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to
Your Excellency's attention the following premeditated Israeli attack:

Last night, 28 July, an Israeli patrol crossed the river Jordan and headed
towards the village of Tel Es-Sukar in the northern part of the Jordan valley.
In their retreat they laid mines on and around the main road in the area.

This morning, 29 July, two of these mines exploded under two civilian cars.
Twelve civilians were seriously injured. Among the casualties was a two-months-
old child. The two cars were badly damaged.

I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated as an official
document of the Security Council.
