LETTER DATED 24 APRIL 1970 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF JORDAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to my letter of today depicting Israel's attacks on civilian targets and upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to Your Excellency's attention the following:

Today, Friday, 24 April 1970, at 0630 and consequently at 0735 hours local time Israeli jets raided civilian targets in the area of Muthalath Es-Salt and the village of Deir Alla respectively.

Five civilians were killed, among them a three-year-old boy and his nine-year-old sister and their father. Their house was destroyed. Seven others were wounded. A civilian car was destroyed and crops were burnt.

I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated as an official document of the Security Council.
