LETTER DATED 5 MAY 1970 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instructions of my Government and with reference to the Secretary-General's note, circulated to the Security Council as document S/9726 of 28 March 1970, informing the members of the Council of his agreement to send, at the request of the parties, a Personal Representative to Bahrain to ascertain the wishes of the people of Bahrain, I have the honour to request an early meeting of the Council to consider the report of the Secretary-General's Personal Representative which has been circulated to members of the Council, under cover of a note by the Secretary-General, as document S/9772 of 30 April 1970.
