DRAFT RESOLUTION

The Security Council,

Noting the communication from the Secretary-General to the Security Council of 28 March 1970,<sup>1/</sup>

Noting the statements made by the representatives of Iran and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland in their letters to the Secretary-General of 9 March 1970 and 20 March 1970, respectively,<sup>2/</sup>

1. Endorses the report of the Secretary-General's Personal Representative, which has been circulated to the Security Council, under cover of a note from the Secretary-General, on 30 April 1970;<sup>3/</sup>

2. Welcomes the conclusions and findings of the report, in particular that "the overwhelming majority of the people of Bahrain wish to gain recognition of their identity in a fully independent and sovereign State free to decide for itself its relations with other States".<sup>4/</sup>
