LETTER DATED 14 FEBRUARY 1968 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMBODIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from my Government and further to my letter No. 689 of 8 February 1968, I have the honour to communicate to you, for the information of the members of the Security Council, the following:

On 2 February 1968:

At about 6.45 a.m., an L.19 observation aircraft of the United States-South Viet-Namese armed forces violated Cambodian air space and fired rockets at civilians working in their rice fields at a place situated about 500 metres within Khmer territory, in the Srok of Preah Bat Chean Chum, province of Takéo. These forces also fired 105 mm cannon at the same place.

Four rocket shells and three 105 mm cannon shells were retrieved.

At about 7.30 p.m., United States-South Viet-Namese armed forces from Tinh Bien (South Viet-Nam) fired 105 mm cannon in the direction of Cambodia. Four shells fell in the village of Phnom-Den, Srok of Preah Bat Chean Chum, province of Takéo.

This deliberate attack caused, on the Khmer side:

one killed and five wounded, three seriously, among the peaceful Khmer villagers;

five oxen wounded;

four houses damaged.

The International Control Commission, the military and press attachés, and reporters from the national and foreign Press, who were invited by the Royal Government to visit the scene of the attack, were able to verify with their own eyes the facts mentioned above.

The Royal Government has lodged a most vigorous protest against this barbarous attack, deliberately perpetrated by the United States-South Viet-Namese armed forces, and has demanded that the Governments of the United States of America and the Republic of Viet-Nam should put an end to such attacks without delay.
