LETTER DATED 4 DECEMBER 1969 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES a.i. OF
GUINEA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to our letter of 2 December 1969 (516/MPG/69) concerning the aggression committed by Portugal against the Republic of Guinea and having regard to the explanations provided in the said letter and to the solidarity shown us by the African group, I have the honour to inform you that the Government of the Republic of Guinea has decided to request you to convene a meeting of the Security Council to consider the vile aggression recently committed by the Portuguese colonial army against the territorial integrity of the Republic of Guinea.

Ambassador El Hadj Abdoulaye Touré, the Permanent Representative, who is at present in the Republic of Guinea for consultations, will arrive in New York on 5 December with full information concerning this infamous act of Portuguese banditry.
