SUMMARY

In accordance with the procedures provided in the Convention, rules of procedure of the Conference of the Parties (COP) and decision 26/COP.1, a list of non-governmental organizations proposed for accreditation at COP 6 is contained herein. The list of national, international, governmental or intergovernmental organizations already accredited to the COP, as well as the updated list of non-governmental organizations, assuming accreditation by the Conference of the Parties at its sixth session of the proposed organizations, are also included.

I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

1. Article 22, paragraph 7 of the Convention states: "The United Nations, its specialized agencies and any State member thereof or observers thereto not Party to the Convention may be represented at sessions of the Conference of the Parties as observers. Any body or agency, whether national or international, governmental or non-governmental, which is qualified in matters covered by the Convention, and which has informed the Permanent Secretariat of its wish to be represented at a session of the Conference of the Parties as an observer, may be so admitted unless at least one third of the Parties present object." Rules 6 and 7 of the rules of procedure (decision 1/COP.1, as contained in ICCD/COP(1)/11/Add.1) contain provisions to similar effect. Furthermore, decision 26/COP.1 contains provisions on accrediting non-governmental and intergovernmental organizations to the first and subsequent sessions of the COP.

II. INTRODUCTION

2. Given that no new accreditation request has been addressed to the secretariat from a national, international, governmental or intergovernmental organization, annex II contains the list of those already accredited to the COP.

3. Assuming accreditation by the COP at its sixth session of the organizations referred to in paragraph 4, annex III contains the updated list of non-governmental organizations accredited to the COP.

III. RECOMMENDATION

4. In accordance with the provisions mentioned above, the secretariat recommends that the Conference of the Parties at its sixth session accredits as observers the non-governmental organizations listed in annex I.
