REPORT OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL GROUP TO MONITOR THE SUPPLY AND SHIPPING OF OIL AND PETROLEUM PRODUCTS TO SOUTH AFRICA

## Note by the Secretary-General

1. On 27 October 1988, the Chairman of the Intergovernmental Group to Monitor the Supply and Shipping of Oil and Petroleum Products to South Africa addressed the following letter to the Secretary-General:

"I have the honour, in accordance with paragraph 4 of General Assembly resolution 42/23 F of 20 November 1987, to transmit the report of the Intergovernmental Group to Monitor the Supply and Shipping of Oil and Petroleum Products to South Africa which was adopted unanimously by the Group on 27 October 1988.
