Non-compliance with resolution 1343 (2001) by the Government of Liberia

I acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 11 August 2003 to which you attached a note dated 23 June 2003 from our Permanent Mission to the United Nations in New York on the above-mentioned subject.

I am to inform you that to the best of our knowledge no maritime companies flying the Ghanaian flag have involved their vessels in acts that violate paragraph 5 of resolution 1343 (2001) within the period under reference.

We wish to assure you that we will keep on monitoring the situation and will notify your office of any violations of the said resolution as soon as they come to our notice.
