LETTER DATED 25 AUGUST 1969 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF PAKISTAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT OF PAKISTAN

The feelings of Muslims throughout the world have been deeply outraged and wounded by the fire in the Al Aqsa Mosque, which is their first Quibla and one of the holiest of Muslim shrines. It would be deplored and condemned by the followers of all faiths in the world. The international community must hold Israel fully responsible for this sacrilegious act. The Security Council should ensure Israeli compliance with its resolutions and observance of the universally recognized principles of civilized behaviour. Pakistan will concert action with other Muslim countries for safeguarding the Muslim Holy Places and for the restoration of Jerusalem. Muslim unity is a paramount necessity at this juncture.
