LETTER DATED 27 AUGUST 1969 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMPODIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from my Government and further to my letter No. 6742 of 1 August 1969, I have the honour to inform you of the following for the information of the members of the Security Council:

During the night of 9-10 August 1969, two helicopters of the United States - South Viet-Namese forces flew over and twice - at approximately 9 p.m. and 2 a.m. - attacked the Cambodian villages of Bos-On, Duanroath and Trapeangrussey in the commune of Roung and the Cambodian village of Sretanong in the commune of Triek, Mimot, province of Kompong Cham, as a result of which:

twenty-seven inhabitants were injured, five of them seriously; one house was set on fire; seven houses were damaged; three buffaloes, three oxen and ten pigs were killed; and other personal property was destroyed.

I should be grateful if you would have the text of this communication circulated as a Security Council document.
