**Preparations for an international meeting to review the implementation  
of the Programme of Action for the Sustainable Development of Small  
Island Developing States**

The Economic and Social Council, recalling General Assembly resolution 57/262 of 20 December 2002 and reiterating the provisions of decision II adopted by the Commission on Sustainable Development at its eleventh session,<sup>1</sup> in particular its paragraph 9, recommends to the Assembly that travel and subsistence allowance for participants from small island developing States to the preparatory meetings and the international meeting to undertake a comprehensive review of the implementation of the Programme of Action for the Sustainable Development of Small Island Developing States<sup>2</sup> be provided from the funds designated by donors for that purpose in the voluntary trust fund established by the Assembly in resolution 57/262.
