At its 36th meeting, on 21 November 1988, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/43/37) on the programme budget implications of draft resolutions A/43/L.23 and A/43/L.24. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/43/SR.36).

### DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolutions A/43/L.23 and A/43/L.24, no modification in the programme of work for the biennium 1988-1989 and no additional resources over and above those already proposed under sections 3 and 27 in the context of the revised estimates for the 1988-1989 programme budget would be required to accommodate the 1989 programme of activities of the Special Committee on the

Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples.

4. A statement in explanation of position was made by the representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
