Extensions of country cooperation frameworks*

Note of the Administrator

Summary

The present note contains information on the first one-year extensions of the second country cooperation frameworks (CCFs) for the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and the Republic of Korea, and the first one-year extension of the first subregional cooperation framework (SCF) for the countries of the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States and Barbados. The Governments concerned requested the extensions.

In accordance with established procedures, the Administrator approves the first one-year extension of CCFs, while requests for extension into a second year or two-year extensions are submitted to the Board for approval. Table 1 presents information on the first one-year CCF extensions approved by the Administrator since the last meeting of the Executive Board.

The Executive Board may wish to take note of the first extensions of the second CCFs for the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and the Republic of Korea, and of the first extension of the first SCF for the countries of the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States and Barbados for a period of one year from 1 January 2004 to 31 December 2004, in table 1, and approve the two-year extension of the CCF for Guyana listed in table 2.
