LETTER DATED 16 FEBRUARY 1983 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF SPAIN CONCERNING RULES 33 TO 35 OF THE RULES OF PROCEDURE

Further to my letter of 24 January 1983, and in accordance with instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that the Ambassador for Disarmament Affairs, Mr. Eduardo de Laiglesia, wishes, in accordance with rule 34 of the Committee's rules of procedure to make a statement in plenary on Thursday, 3 March, dealing essentially with chemical weapons.

The Government of Spain would also like to take part in the meetings of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Chemical Weapons through the attendance of an expert.

Once the Committee's agenda and programme of work for 1983 are known, the Government of Spain will submit to the Committee for consideration the matter of the attendance of another expert who would collaborate in some other Working Group which might be set up.
