LETTER DATED 31 JANUARY 1983 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF PORTUGAL ADDRESSED TO THE
CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE ON DISARMAMENT
CONCERNING RULES 33 TO 35 OF THE RULES
OF PROCEDURE

I have the honour to refer to the rules of procedure of the Committee on Disarmament regarding the participation of the non-member States of the Committee and request that Portugal through its Permanent Mission in Geneva would be allowed to participate in the work of the Committee during the first part of its 1983 session.
